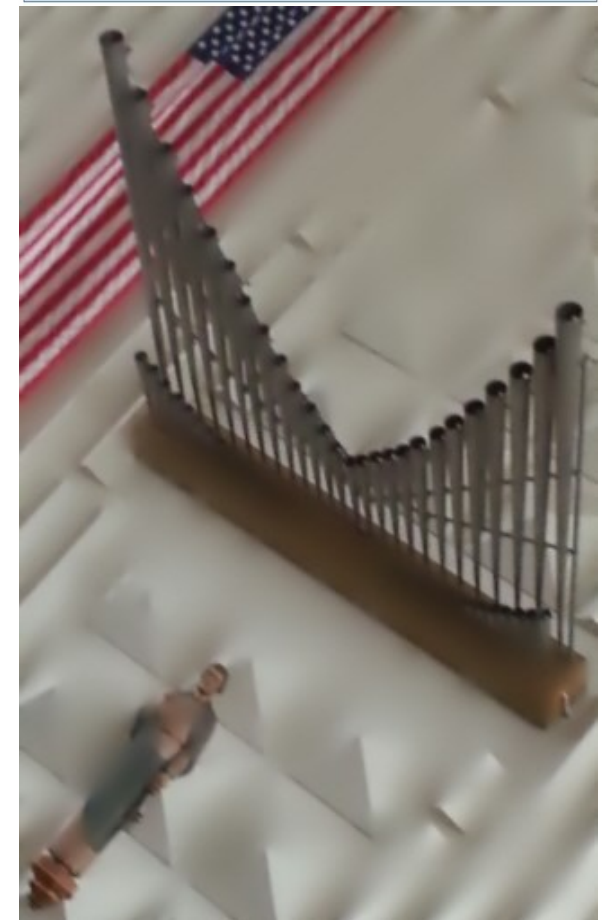

### MARK ENGELHARDT



Organist and Choirmaster at St. Peter's from 1984 to 1989, Mr. Engelhardt served as Organist and Director of Music at St.

Paul's Episcopal Cathedral in Boston from 1989 to 2005, and in a similar position at Grace Episcopal Church in Salem, MA. Returning to St. Peter's in January 2013, Mr. Engelhardt has recently established the new Center for the Arts at St. Peter's. A prize-winning solo recitalist, he has performed in such venues as Trinity Church, Wall Street; Bristol and Truro Cathedrals in the UK; and Methuen Music Hall, and collaborates with trumpet player Chris O'Hara. This organ recital will preview a program he will play on the world-famous concert organ at Methuen Music Hall in July, including a world premiere of a newly commissioned work by James Woodman.
